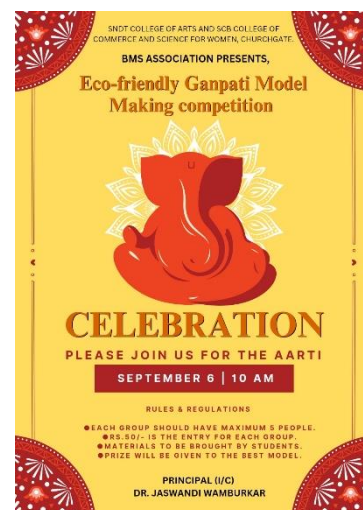


## Eco-friendly Ganpati Model Making Competition
